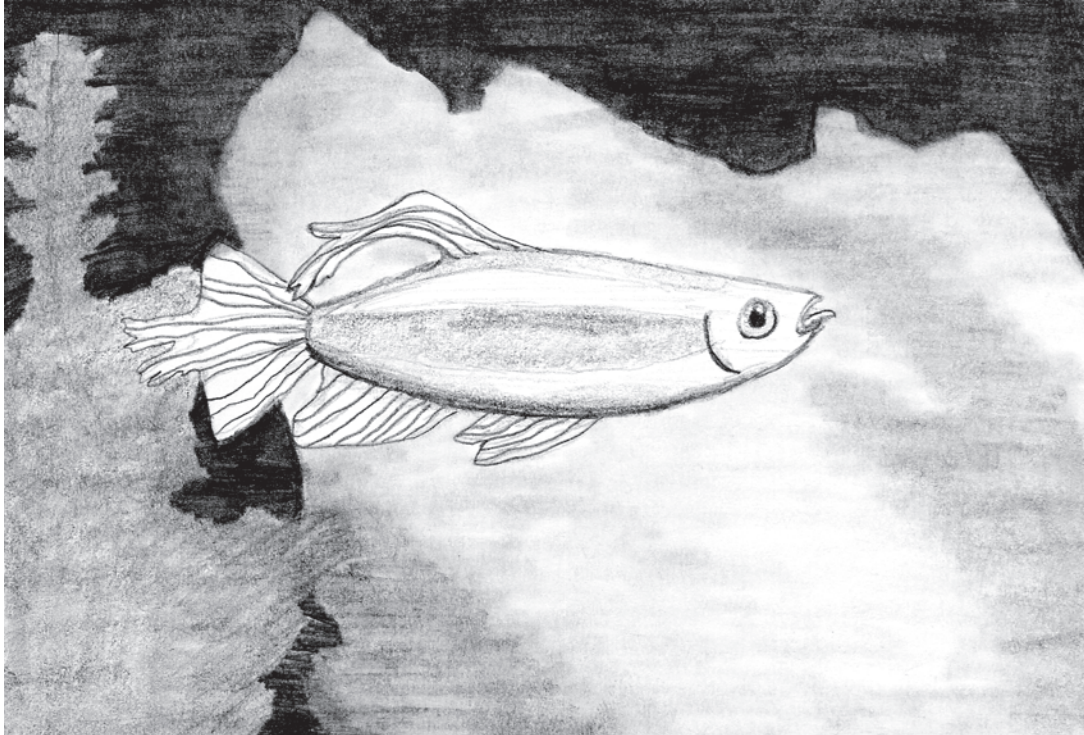


Fish

Matthew 4:18

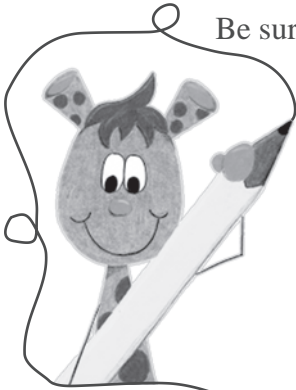


This is a drawing of a fish I saw in a pet store one day. Isn't God's design for the fish amazing? Imagine being able to live under water! Blub. Blub. Blub.

Zooki's Pencil Points

There are shadows under water, too! Notice how the underside of the fish is darker than the top, just like the pencil you drew in the previous lesson.

Be sure to leave a white spot in the fish's eye. This makes him look more alive.



Use the side of your pencil and your blending stump to create the two lighter shades of the background.

You will need to use the point of your pencil to color the darkest part of the background.

Make sure your pencil is nice and sharp when you draw the lines on the fish's fins.

Hey, that's fun to say. Can you say "fish's fins" ten times fast?
